Resource description	This collection of 22 resources focuses on the struggle to achieve equal pay in Australia. The collection is organised in eight categories - less pay for women; less pay for Indigenous Australians; leaders in the struggle; the Victorian tailoresses' strike of 1882-83; the Torres Strait pearl divers' strike of 1936; the Pilbara stockmen's strike of 1946-49; the 1966 equal pay decision for Indigenous pastoral workers; and women achieve equal pay in the 1970s.
